Check-in:

When:

Where:

Bear Athletic Center // 1201 10th Ave, Grinnell, IA

What to do:

- Leave luggage in vehicle
- Bring completed & signed “Camper Health Form” (available at <http://sgu.camp>)
- Bring all medication in Ziploc bag with the camper’s full name in permanent marker on it
- Spending money (cash only) for “bank”

Dorm Rooms & Keys:

Each camper will be issued one key to their dorm room. Dorm room keys are the responsibility of their camper.

Lost keys require a \$75 replacement fee from the camper prior to their departure from camp.

Final Payment:

The complete \$325 for camp must be paid by June 15, 2018.

Bring:

- Bible
- Notebook & writing utensil
- Tennis Shoes
- Bathing suit (females: one piece; males: no spandex/speedos)
- Towel & sunscreen
- Water bottle (with name on it)
- Toiletries
 - Shampoo, conditioner, soap
 - toothbrush, toothpaste
 - Deodorant
 - Shower shoes
- Fan (small)
- Alarm clock
- Backpack / string bag
- Linens:
 - Twin flat & fitted sheets
 - Blanket
 - Pillow
 - Pillow case
 - Towel
 - Washcloths
- Clothing for four nights & four days
 - Shorts/capris/jeans
 - T-shirts
 - Under garments

Summer Games University is NOT responsible for lost, stolen or damaged items; campers are responsible for the safe-keeping and protection of personal items at all times.

Cell phones may only be out and used during prescribed times. Earbuds are permitted only in dorms.

Dress Code:

SGU is a Christian camp, we recommend loose fitting shorts and t-shirts for all campers.

Here are the specifics:

- All tops (shirts, dresses) must have sleeves
- No exposed underwear
- No short-shorts
- Closed-toe shoes required before dinner (sandals can be worn to dinner and night time worship, but not during the day)
